 3. The last dialogue box will appear indicating Setup was completed successfully. **Click on the Close Button.** (See image 3)

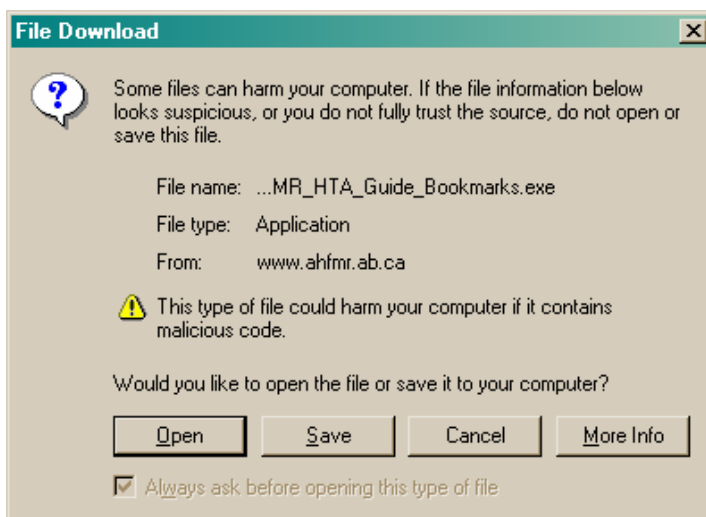

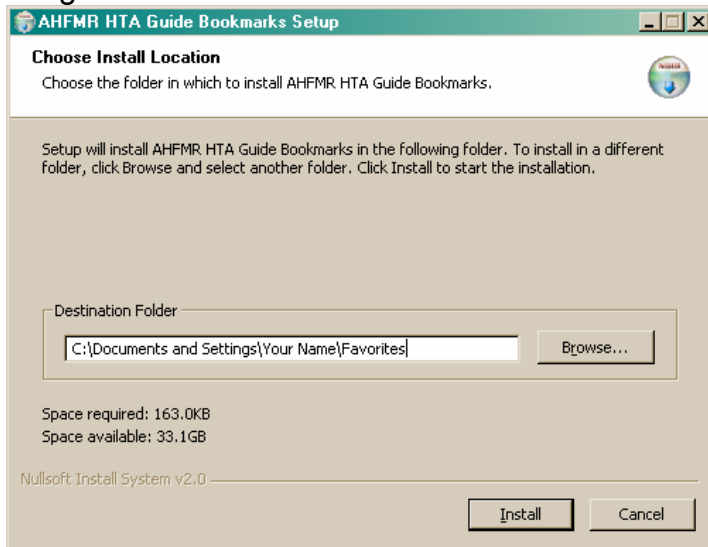
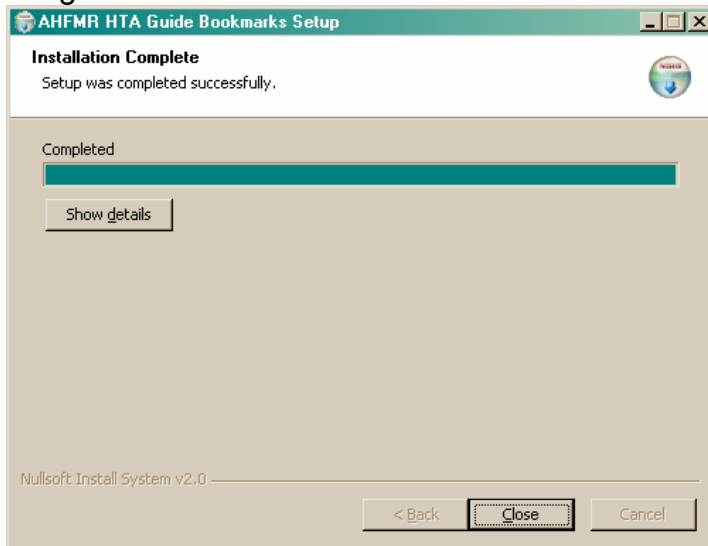
