  3. The last dialogue box will appear indicating Setup was completed successfully. Click on the Close Button. (See image 3)

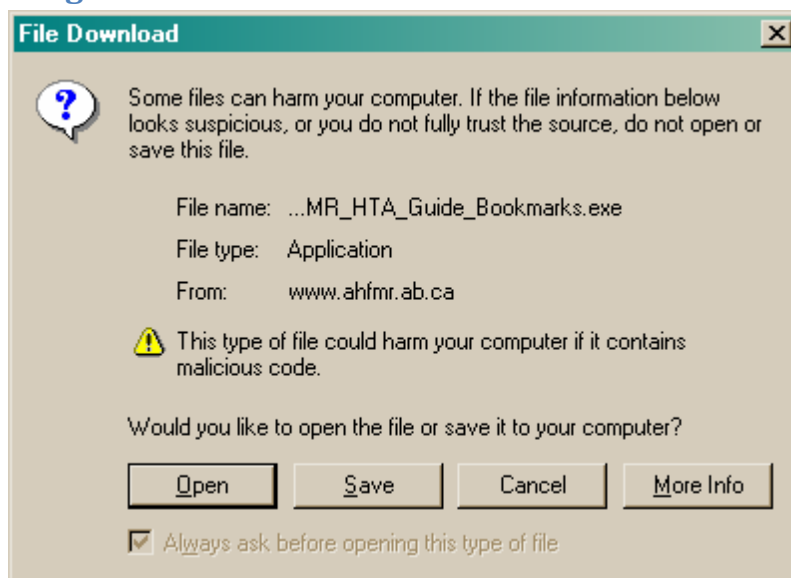

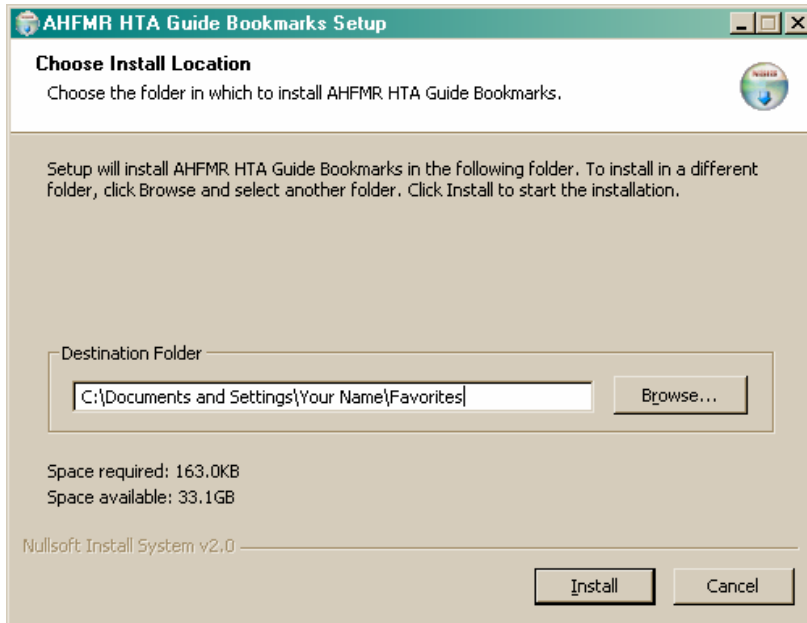
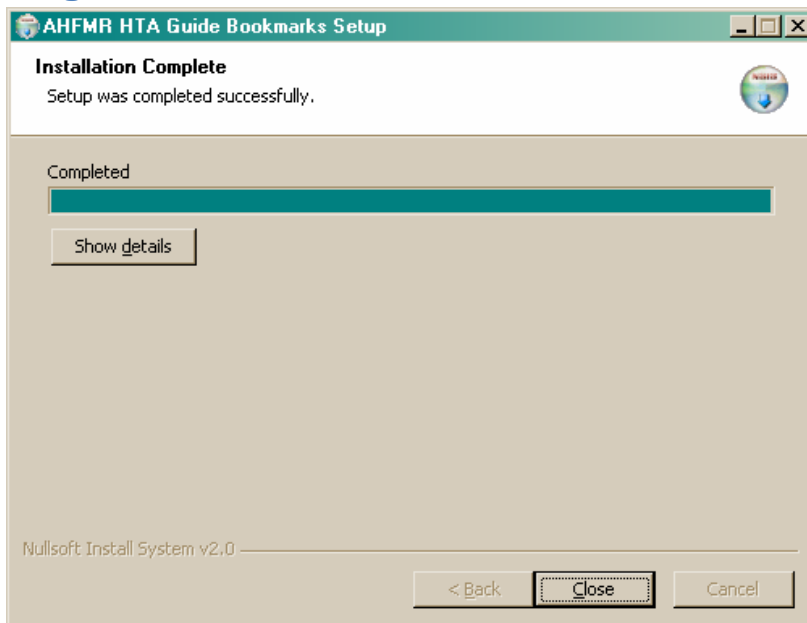
